


Tokai 3 Days Day3



WOC2005Aichi 20th Anniversary Tournament

Date 2025 May 5th (Holiday)

Venue: Showa no Mori (Toyota City, Aichi Prefecture)

Organizer: Aichi Prefecture Orienteering Association

It has been 20 years since the World Orienteering Championships (WOC) was held in Aichi, Japan, for the first time in Asia. We will be holding an event that will evoke the excitement of that time!

The course for the men's and women's finals at that time will be recreated!

There will also be a special race designed by Ito Itsuki.

(Also Aichi Prefectural Orienteering Tournament)

■ Access

Get off at the Oiden bus "Nishinakayama" bus stop and walk about 2km.

By car:

Approximately 4km from Toyota Fujioka IC on the Tokaido Loop Expressway .

Or, take Sanage Green Road, exit Nakayama IC and go about 3km.

Please be sure to use Parking Lot No. 5 (see the picture on the right).

■ Venue and reception

“Koryukan” Annex: Reception opens at 10:00AM (scheduled)

There are changing tents for men and women. There are no shops or other facilities.

■ Competition

Competition format : Point orienteering

Start time : 11:00AM (scheduled) No pre - specified start time. Start at your own preferred time.

Map : Scale 1: 5000 Contour interval : 2.5 m Runability 5level. A4 size. Self- sealed in a waterproof vinyl bag .

Competition rules : Compliant with the Japan Orienteering Competition Rules.

Control position explanation IOF symbols (N class is written in Japanese as well)

Timing system : EMIT Electronic Punch System . Lift-up start and punching finish.

• Courses 1 and 2 will be the final race of the WOC2005 Sprint.

• Extra Course 4 is a special race hosted by Ito Tatsuki.

No application is required for the Extra Course, and advanced class riders can participate (you can participate in two races).

Participation in the extra course is optional.

- The target age for each class is the age that will be reached by March 31, 2026. Participants in individual competitions must be 12 years of age or older.
- Group classes must be attended by a minimum of 2 people and a maximum of 5 people. The representative must be 12 years of age or older.
- The course distance is currently planned and may be subject to change.

- You will need an EMIT E-card to keep track of your timing. E-cards can be rented, but this will cost 300 yen in addition to the participation fee.
- Compasses will be loaned to anyone who requests one free of charge.
- The tournament program will be uploaded to the official website one week before the tournament. If you would like the tournament program to be mailed to you in advance, please let us know by email.

■ Awards

There will be no award ceremony. The top three winners in each class will be mailed a certificate at a later date.

In the extra course, prizes will also be awarded up to the top three according to class.
